Reiss & Co. Group and PEG Hamburg acquire Leder-Schüler complex in Hamburg

Munich/Hamburg 22nd of July 2019 – The Reiss & Co. Group, hast entered into a joint venture with PEG - Projektentwicklungsgesellschaft Hamburg mbH, and acquired the Kontorhaus Leder-Schüler-Höfe at Heidenkampsweg 32 to 34 and Nordkanalstrasse 58, in the Hammerbrook district of Hamburg. The vendor of the property, which stands on a 3,800 square metre site, is a Hamburg family company. The parties have agreed to keep the sale price confidential.

70% of the Leder-Schüler-Höfe are let for mixed office and hotel use. The complex is currently occupied by the Ambassador Hotel and various commercial tenants.

The partially listed building was constructed in traditional clinker brickwork in 1928 to plans by Fritz Höger, who also designed the Chilehaus. It is situated only a few metres from the Berliner Tor U-Bahn and S-Bahn station. The Hammerbrook district has undergone continual positive development in recent years. This includes the construction of 1,500 new apartments and numerous hotels, while Olympus has based its European headquarters there. Following planned refurbishment works, the purchaser is aiming for a hotel or office use. The property was in family ownership for almost 100 years.
